- Decorate the room with bikes, skateboards, helmets, pads, etc.
- Look for posters and coloring sheets on the web or at parent/teacher stores.

## **Safety Awareness**

- How to be safe at home
- How to be safe at school
- How to be safe on the playground
- Good touch, bad touch
- Find free materials on the web
- Put take-home advice in a packet for parents
- Decorate the room with posters of happy, safe children playing; Use child friendly posters on wall
- Use a poster and ruler to measure height

## **Fearfully and Wonderfully Made**

- Teach children how God created our different body parts to work together
- What to expect at the doctor's office
- What a fever means
- W pain means
- Have hands on learning opportunities for children to listen to their heart while you briefly tell how the heart works
- Explain why we protect our heads
- Explain why exercise is good and involve them in some fun and playful exercises
- Decorate the room with anatomical posters

## **Dental Health**

- Teach good dental hygiene and why healthy teeth and gums are important
- Contact toothpaste companies for videos, toothbrushes, paste, floss
- Invite a dental hygienist to speak
- Explain what happens at the dentist office
- Give each child a zip-lock with dental products
- Decorate the room with dental posters.
