

Alabama Challenge Team

Alabama Challenge Team is made up of Acteens or teen girls who live
Colossians 3 from *The Message*.

“So if you’re serious about living this new resurrection life with Christ, act like it. Pursue the things over which Christ presides. Don’t shuffle along, eyes to the ground, absorbed with things right in front of you. Look up, and be alert to what is going on around Christ—that’s where the action is.” Colossians 3, The Message

Alabama Challenge Team members will exemplify Christ as they represent Alabama Acteens and Girls’ Ministry for our state by:

1. Participating in the planning and leading of *COMPLETE.... For girls grades 7-12* according to their individual gifts. Team members will be required to attend *COMPLETE* and must provide their own transportation; housing and food expenses will be provided by Alabama WMU.
2. Sharing their testimony verbally and/or in written form.
3. Writing an article for “Panorama”, the Alabama WMU newsletter.
4. Helping to strengthen and encourage Acteens or Girls Ministry groups by visiting and sharing with them personal experiences from their Christian walk. Team members must be willing to visit at least three Acteens or Girls Ministry groups or associational events as their schedule allows.
5. Representing Alabama WMU, Acteens, or Girls’ Ministry at other events as requested and as schedule will allow.

Alabama Acteens Advisors or Adult Leaders will be asked to support their Alabama Challenge Team member by:

1. Providing her with Christ like love, support and encouragement.
2. Assisting her in setting up speaking engagements.
3. Helping her prepare for speaking engagements and/or church/association events.
All Challenge Team members will be eligible for a missions involvement scholarship for up to \$150.00 during their year of service.

To Apply, Girls:

1. Must be entering the tenth grade or above, or be 15 years old by September 1st.
2. Must be a member of a local Acteens™ organization OR Girls’ Ministry group and an active member of a Southern Baptist Church in Alabama.
3. Must complete application and write paragraphs describing (please type paragraphs):
 - A) “How I Became A Christian and How I Have Grown as a Christian During the Past Year”
 - B) “Why Acteens or Girls’ Ministry is Important to Me”
 - C) “Why I Want to Serve on the Alabama Challenge Team.”
 - D) “An idea for a conference to be offered at *COMPLETE*.”
4. Must agree to serve from September 1st to August 31st. Team members may participate in *COMPLETE* programming as well as other Acteens™ promotion and/or state sponsored events.
5. **Must have completed application to Alabama WMU no later than May 6, 2011.** Applications must include **most recent and clearest passport size photo**, parent’s signature, Acteens or Girls’ Ministry Advisor/Director’s signature, and requested paragraphs.

Only fully completed applications will be considered

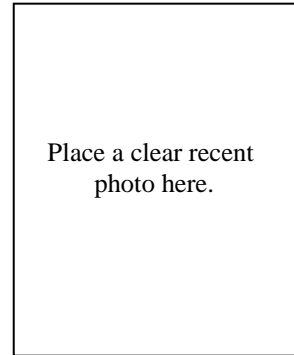
